GOV.1 ADVISORY BOARD

The Owner of the Agency will convene an Advisory Board, the objective of which shall be to provide input and guidance with respect to the Mental Health needs of the communities served by the agency.

The recommendations of the Advisory Board shall be given full consideration by Ownership; however, such recommendations will not be binding upon the Agency. Wherever appropriate, such recommendations will be incorporated into the strategic plan and/or the organization's policies.

The Advisory Board shall consist of stakeholders and interested parties and may include:

- Parents
- School Representatives
- Primary Care Providers
- Clergy
- Legal Representatives
- Mental Health Professionals
- Recipients of mental health services
- Others as deemed appropriate

The Advisory Board will meet semi-annually. The CEO will ensure that all members of the Advisory Board are notified of meetings in a timely fashion.

Members of the Advisory Board will select a Chairperson. Minutes will be kept for Advisory Board meetings and will be distributed to all members of the Advisory Board.

Advisory Board meetings will be attended by CEO of the Agency or designee and by such other members of the Agency's executive or other staff as Ownership may deem appropriate.
