PM. 23 Clinical and Non-Clinical Supervision

Clinical Staff

Clinical supervision shall include, but not be limited to, current clinical cases.

All employees and affiliates providing clinical services will be provided with no less clinical supervision than the following:

- Supervision as required by Cornerstone Behavioral Healthcare or program licensing department, and MaineCare requirements
- Supervision with students will be done at least 1 hour per week, or more frequently if necessary

Documentation of supervision shall be kept in an individual training and supervision file and held in confidence by HR and their supervisor.

Affiliates will have the opportunity for supervision by licensed clinical staff or provide proof of supervision that they have received.

Non-Clinical Staff

Non-Clinical staff will meet with their supervisor at least one hour per month or more frequently if necessary.
